Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information received on the 19th July 2024. We can confirm that the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Integrated Care Board can provide the following information.

Please see our responses in blue below:

I would like to request the following information under the Freedom of Information Act.

For each sub-ICB location (using the latest boundaries) in your area, could you provide the number of young people aged 11 to 25 inclusive who presented in A&E or urgent care with a mental health diagnosis in calendar years 2017, 2019, 2021, and 2023? Additionally, please split this data into two age groups: 11-18 and 19-25.

Please include diagnoses with the following ICD-10 codes in any diagnostic position:

- **F20-29: Schizophrenia, schizotypal and delusional disorders**
- **F30-39: Mood disorders**
- **F40-49: Neurotic, stress-related and somatoform disorders**
- **F50-59: Behavioural syndromes associated with physiological disturbances and physical factors**
- **F60-69: Disorders of adult personality and behaviour**

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Chief Executive Officer: Peter Axon

- **F90-98: Behavioural and emotional disorders with onset usually occurring in childhood and adolescence**
- **F99: Unspecified mental disorder**
- **G47: Disorders of initiating and maintaining sleep [insomnias]**
- **Z91.5: Personal history of self-harm**

We are not able to respond to the FOI due to the ICD10 (Diagnostic) element not being a field in the A&E data set to extract those patients attending with Mental Health related issues.

There has been a move to ECDS (Emergency Care Data Set) with criteria for capturing the reason for attendance changing three times during the years in question. The Snomed codes for the period covered have changed in depth and breadth, as a result will not provide a meaningful breakdown comparison.

Should you require any further information or clarification regarding this response please do not hesitate to contact us. If you are dissatisfied with the response, you are entitled to request an internal review which should be formally requested in writing and must be within two calendar months from the date this response was issued.

To request an internal review
