Is your child's school asthma friendly?

The Asthma Friendly Schools Programme brings together NHS, schools and Local Authorities to manage children and young people with asthma at primary and secondary schools.

Through training, schools can ensure children and young people with asthma are safe within an asthma friendly environment. It will also:

- Increase confidence among school staff in asthma management
- Improve the quality of life for children with asthma in school
- Reduce absences due to asthma
- Improve partnership working between schools and the NHS



Together we can work to reduce harm and improve the quality of life for children and young people.

By completing the programme, the school will have the following in place:



A register of children with asthma



A care plan for each child with asthma



An asthma policy



Emergency inhaler kits in school



Whole staff training
